School Meals

Our children have a choice of a hot school meal, a packed lunch or going home for their lunch. The current daily price for a school meal is £2.40 for pupils in Years 3 – 6. Daily meals for Nursery pupils is £2.00. If you feel you may be entitled to free school meals, please speak to a member of our school office who will be able to assist you. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are automatically eligible for Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM). A menu of our school meals can be accessed on our website.

Springfield encourages our children to eat a healthy and balanced diet and encourages parents to ensure children having a packed lunch have a balanced lunch too. 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School Uniform

The wearing of uniform contributes to a sense of belonging and encourages high standards of discipline and expectations.

Boys:

- Grey or black trousers (or shorts for summer)
- White shirt or white polo shirt, tucked in
- Green jumper or sweatshirt, preferably with the Springfield logo
- Sensible, smart and plain black school shoes no trainers
- Plain black, grey or white socks

Girls:

- Grey or black skirt, trousers or pinafore
- White blouse, shirt or white polo shirt
- Grey or black shorts for summer or a green and white summer dress
- Green cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt, preferably with the Springfield logo
- Sensible, smart and plain black school shoes no trainers
- Plain black, grey or white socks or tights
- Green, black or grey headscarf (if required to be worn for religious observance)



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School Uniform continued:

PE Kit:

- White T-shirt and black jogging bottoms (during the winter, children may wear plain black shorts)
- Black pumps or trainers for outdoor PE.

Pupils are required to wear their full PE kit to school on the day that they have PE. Please ensure your child is wearing their school jumper or cardigan on top of their PE kit.

Pupils in Nursery and Reception do not require a PE kit.
