Fasting Reminder

If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and you have given consent for them to fast, please ensure you let the office know in the morning if your child will not be fasting. This is to ensure that a meal is prepared for them and ParentPay is updated accordingly. Can you check your ParentPay account balance over the weekend and let the school office know if you notice any errors as soon as possible so amendments can be made.

6 Days of Giving

We have learned from our Muslim friends and families that Ramadan is a time to reflect on how fortunate we are, and to remember and give charity to those less fortunate than ourselves.

In the spirit of giving to others (sadaqah) we would like to set a foodbank challenge to support our 10 good deeds this academic year.

Therefore, from Friday 15th March to Friday 22nd March, we are asking children to gift an item to our food bank collection each day:

Springfield's six days of giving (sadaqah).

The items should be non-perishable (canned goods, pasta, rice, lentils etc) and within their use-by date. Every little helps and so whatever you can donate will be greatly received.

Leave In Term Time Fines

We would like to remind parents that leave in term time is not authorised and fines will be issued by Birmingham City Council for parents/carers who take their children out of school. We have been advised by Birmingham City Council that Leave In Term Time fines will be increasing from £60 per child per parent/carer to £80. We have also been advised that ALL adults in the same household can be fined. If fines are not paid in 3 weeks, this will increase to £160.

We will be holding a Charity Cake Sale for children throughout the day on Friday 22nd March to raise money for children affected by war. Shop bought donations are welcome if you would like to contribute. Anything that is not sold during the day will be available for parents/cares to buy at the end of the day from the playground.
