Dark trainers can be worn on PE days.

Medication

If your child has an allergy or illness and is required to have medication during the school day, please ensure that the medication is handed in to the school office.

A medication form will need to be completed by parents/carers before we can administer any medication to your child.

Please **DO NOT** give the medication to your child to bring to school.

Change of Details

It is essential that we have up to date contact details for parents/carers.

If you, or one of the named contacts for your child need to update any contact details, including email addresses and telephone numbers please contact the school office on 0121 464 3618 and inform us as soon as possible.

For any change of address details, we will need to see proof of address before we can update our systems.

School Dinner

Please be advised that Universal Free School Meals are paid for and provided by the government to children in Reception – Year 2.

If your child is in Year 3 – 6 and has a school meal, you will be charged £2.40 a day unless you are entitled to free school meals.

Please contact the school office if you need to make a claim for free school meals or need a login for Parent pay.

It is the parents/carers responsibility to advise the school of any changes in circumstances.

Attendance and Punctuality

School gates open at 8:45am and close at 8:55am, after this your child will be considered late.

The College Rd gate is open from 8:30am for wake up shake up if you need to drop your child earlier for any reason.

If your child arrives after 9:30am they will receive a 'U' code which is an unauthorised absence for the morning. As a result, this will have a significant impact on attendance and could lead to further action being taken.

If you are struggling to arrive on time and would like some support, please speak to Miss Stringer or Mrs Hussain.

If your child is not well enough to attend school, please remember to follow the absence procedures and report this to the school office before 9:00am if possible.
